To that end, the Family Life Pastor - Student Specialist would bear two primary responsibilities. First, they would support the full complement of Family Ministry programs (nursery through high school, marriage and parenting) at one location in order to strengthen the family relationships of that particular location. Second, they would drive the primary programs of Student Ministry across all of our locations, strengthening the discipleship of teens across our entire congregation specifically through the ORANGE strategy.

The Family Life Pastor's role has both decentralized (location-specific) and centralized (church-wide) aspects to it.

## The following is a summary of the two primary responsibilities the successful person would oversee:

- 1. Family Life Location Leader (Decentralized)
  - a. Build and Drive the primary programs designed to support families at a particular location (0-18 years + Marriage and Parenting initiatives)
  - b. Recruit and support volunteer lead teams
  - c. Champion family ministry values location wide
  - d. Partner with the location leader to develop a plan to serve and care for families at the location
  - e. Work with the other family life pastors to have a united strategy and program plan across locations

#### 2. Family Life Pastor - Students (Centralized)

- a. Develop and implement a strategy to reach and disciple our Jr. & Sr. high school students across all locations
- b. Oversee and build R!OT (Jr. high midweek and Sunday morning) and CURRENT (Sr. high midweek) programs that engage and inspire our students (including occasional weekend retreats and /or things like mission trips, etc.)
- c. Train and develop volunteer teams that are responsible to implement the programs according to the vision
- d. Equip and support family life pastors to drive student ministries in the locations
